
Map and Directions




To get to St. Joe from Ft. Wayne: Exit I-69, at DuPont Road exit 316. Continue northeast on State Road 1, following it about 17 miles to St. Joe.

To get to St. Joe from Auburn:

Take State Road 8, via exit 329, East approximately 10 miles to State Road 1 intersection. Turn south on State Road 1 about 2 miles to St. Joe. Festival will be located on the South side of town.
