## The Big Dill Coed Quad Grass Volleyball Tournament Rules of Play

- 1. No more than two men per team
- 2. Teams must register players prior to the start of their first game, and no substitutions. A minimum of two players must be on the court, if players are not present by the start of the game, team forfeits game.
- 3. Net will be at 7'8"
- 4. Games will be rally score
  - a. Pool Play will consist of two games to 21, win by 2, cap at 30
  - b. Tournament Play will consist of best two of three games, first 2 games to 21, win by 2, cap at 30, 3<sup>rd</sup> game to 15, win by 2, no cap, switch sides at 7
- 5. Attire players must be fully clothed (shirt and shorts/pants) and may wear their own team shirts, if desired. Players may choose to be barefoot or wear shoes (with no plastic or metal cleats).
- 6. Court will measure 59' x 29.5'
- 7. Coin Toss Ref will host toss between team captains. "Home Team" will be designated on the schedule and will call the toss. Winner chooses either serve or side. Teams will switch sides between games.
- 8. Teams must maintain service order. If serves are made out of order, adjustments should be made to regain serving order and no points lost, ref may call replay at their discretion. If teams are clearly abusing this issue, Ref may give warning, which could lead to disqualification.
- 9. Warmup for first game of play per day is 5 min and 3 minutes for reach subsequent game.
- 10. Let serve is not permitted. No blocking on the serve.
- 11. Serves may be received overhead.
- 12. No open hand tipping over the net (can use fist)
- 13. No setting or overhead passing over the net with fingers (such that trajectory is placed on the ball)
- 14. Each Team can call 1 timeout per game (lasting 1 minute)
- 15. Good sportsmanship is expected at all times from participants and spectators. Please do not

argue with refs. Players must respect property and equipment. Any issues can be addressed directly with the EYVB Directors. Anyone conducting themselves in an unsportsmanlike way and creating difficulties for other players, fans, referees, or staff may be asked to leave.

16. All Players must sign a waiver of liability prior to play – minors are encouraged to play; however, they must have a parent or guardian sign a release prior to play.
